
St. Joseph Pilgrim Icon Prayer Service

Let us Spread devotion to St. Joseph and pray for the courage to stand up and carry out our mission of protecting marriage and family, defending, and raising future generations.




Stations of the Cross

Redvers—Fridays during Lent, 7:00 p.m.

The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross or “Via Crucis”, commemorate Jesus’s passion and death on the cross. There are 14 stations that each depict a moment on his journey to Calvary, usually through sacred art, prayers, and reflections. The practice began as pious pilgrims traced his path through Jerusalem on the Via Dolorosa (The Sorrowful Way). Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not make the trip to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church throughout the world.

The Fourteen Stations Of The Cross

1. Jesus Is Condemned to Death. 2. Jesus Takes Up His Cross. 3. Jesus Falls the First Time. 4. Jesus Meets His Sorrowful Mother. 5. Simon of Cyrene Helps Jesus Carry the Cross. 6. Veronica Wipes the Face of Jesus. 7. Jesus Falls a Second Time. 8. Jesus Meets the Women of Jerusalem. 9. Jesus Falls the Third Time. 10. Jesus Is Stripped of His Garments. 11. Jesus Is Nailed to the Cross. 12. Jesus Dies on the Cross. 13. Jesus Is Taken Down From the Cross. 14. Jesus Is Laid in the Tomb.
